<u>American</u> money says: "In God We Trust" ... beginning 1864 On the penny, since 1909 / On the dime, since 1916 / On paper money, since 1957

OBSERVATIONS...

Both God and money promise "life" but money is lying! Only God is telling the truth.

Luke 12:15

"Beware, and be on your guard against every form of greed; for not even when one has an abundance does his life consist of his possessions."

"Life" is mysterious stuff... "My So-called Life? "COKE adds life... to everything"

"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly.

Deuteronomy 30:15-19

"See, I have set before you today life and prosperity, and death and adversity;

in that I command you today to love the LORD your God, to walk in His ways and to keep His commandments and His statutes and His judgments, that you may live and multiply, and that the LORD your God may bless you in the land where you are entering to possess it.

"But if your heart turns away and you will not obey, but are drawn away and worship other gods and serve them, I declare to you today that you shall surely perish. You will not prolong your days in the land where you are crossing the Jordan to enter and possess it.

"I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse. So **choose life in order that you may live**, you and your descendants...

"Life" is a gift of God. And therefore anything that, in any way, draws us away from Him steals life!

b) Both God and money promise security but money is exaggerating! God is telling the truth.

1 Timothy 6:17

Instruct those who are rich in this present world not to be conceited or to fix their hope on the uncertainty of riches, but on *God*, who *richly supplies us with all things to enjoy*.

Just as mysterious as "life" in any qualitative sense is "joy"... It's what everyone is seeking. And some people spend their whole lives failing to achieve it... "no talent for happiness"

Psalms 16:11

You will make known to me the path of life; *In Your presence is fullness of joy*; In Your right hand there are pleasures forever.

c) Both God and money demand <u>faith (a commitment of trust and obedience.) Only God is trustworthy!</u>

Hebrews 11:6

And without <u>faith</u> it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must <u>believe that He is</u> and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.

Matthew 6:24-34

"No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and

despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth. For this reason I say to you, do not be worried about your life, as to what you will eat or what you will drink; nor for your body, as to what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? ... for your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. So do not worry about tomorrow; for tomorrow will care for itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own."

1 Timothy 6:9-12
