Paul the apostle came to town, He preached.

He persuaded. People "went for it"... "faith, love, hope"

Their faith. love. hope: things to thank God for!

NOTE: A second thing to thank God for! But it's really the same thing! *Faith, love, hope:* by the Word at work in them. e.q.

Romans 15:4 For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.

Two sides of the same story: God's sovereignty; our responsibility: good theology + good living ♥

Two sides of the story for two practical purposes: To know who to thank / to know what to do

So then WHAT TO DO WITH THE WORD OF GOD → "the word of God, which is at work in you believers" (re: What we have been given to do: evangelism and being an example: getting the gospel out/ the gospel in.) An analogy would help! This work that the word of God carries out is compared in the Bible to the work of a sword. Ephesians 6:17 and take ... the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God... (Written ten years after 1 Thes. 5:8)

Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, *piercing* to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and *discerning* the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Revelation 1:16 ... from his mouth came a sharp two-edged sword, and his face was like the sun shining in full strength.

In the days of warfare by sword, the help that a sword could give depended on THREE THINGS THAT WERE REQUIRED

1) You must have possession of it! ==→ □ (Photo: Frodo)

John 14:21 Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me. And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him."

Ephesians 6:17 and take ... the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God...

Accept the word of God as what it is: *a sword*! For two purposes: *evangelising* (*Speak it!*) and *exemplifying*. (Be personally worked on by it)

2) You must learn how to use it A word to the pacifists.

"The word is **ALSO** *a lamp"* **No Step #2.** (Not much to learn about using a lamp!)

But a sword requires skill!

Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, *piercing* to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and *discerning* the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Learn how to use the word of God as what it is: the *piercing, discerning* instrument of God! For two purposes: *evangelising* (*Speak it!*) and *exemplifying*. (*Be personally worked on by it!*)

e.g. **1 Thessalonians 5:11** Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing.

Ephesians 4:29 Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for building up, as fits the occasion, that it may give grace to those who hear.

→ And trust God to use it, and to teach you how to use it!
Ephesians 6:18praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. → 1 Thes. 2:13

BECAUSE the truth doesn't work "automatically."

We often see how the Bible confuses and provokes people

Matthew 7:6 Do not give dogs what is holy, and do not throw your pearls before pigs, lest they trample them underfoot and turn to attack you.

3) And you must actually use it!

"Take it with you!"

Don't just stand there. Say something biblical! *Draw your sword*! (*Hold up the lamp!*) (Pray and then) say Bible things!

Ephesians 6:17 and take ... the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God...
