Current state of the youth in our city:

- Young adults (19-25) leaving church at a high rate due to irrelevance of faith personally and in community
- Issues of healthy identity/Personal value
- Value of Life in view of pop culture/Violence/Bullying
- Dealing with Guilt & Shame & Despondency & turning to Suicide

I. Keep it simple and intentional

The Lord now chose seventy-two other disciples and sent them ahead in pairs to all the towns and places he planned to visit. These were his instructions to them: "The harvest is great, but the workers are few. So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask him to send more workers into his fields. Now go, and remember that I am sending you out as lambs among wolves. Don't take any money with you, nor a traveler's bag, nor an extra pair of sandals. And don't stop to greet anyone on the road. -Luke 10:1-4

- Not overcomplicating the mission
- Avoiding the distraction of busyness
- Looking for where God is at work and aligning
- Keeping it about people and relationship
- Staying focused on why we do what we do

II. Bring God's peace and live life in your community

"Whenever you enter someone's home, first say, 'May God's peace be on this house.' If those who live there are peaceful, the blessing will stand; if they are not, the blessing will return to you. Don't move around from home to home. Stay in one place, eating and drinking what they provide. Don't hesitate to accept hospitality, because those who work deserve their pay.
