HE SAW...

II. He Summarizes Their Spiritual Condition	Rev. 2:9 <p>'I know your tribulation and your poverty (but you are rich), and the blasphemy by those who say they are Jews and are not, but are a synagogue of Satan.</p> <p>Rev. 2:4 <p>'I know your deeds and your toil and perseverance, and that you cannot tolerate evil men, and you put to the test those who call themselves apostles, and they are not, and you found them to be false; <sup>3</sup> and you have perseverance and have endured for My name's sake, and have not grown weary.<sup>4</sup> But I have this against you, that you have left your first love.</p></p>	Rev. 2:13-15 <p>'I know where you dwell, where Satan's throne is; and you hold fast My name, and did not deny My faith even in the days of Antipas, My witness.</p> <p>My faithful one, who was killed among you, where Satan dwells.<sup>14</sup> But I have a few things against you, because you have there some who hold the teaching of Balaam, who kept teaching Balak to put a stumbling block before the sons of Israel, to eat things sacrificed to idols and to commit acts of immorality.<sup>15</sup> So you also have some who in the same way hold the teaching of the Nicolaitans.</p>	Rev. 2:19-23 <p>'I know your deeds, and your love and faith and service and perseverance, and that your deeds of late are greater than at first.<sup>20</sup> But I have this against you, that you tolerate the woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, and she teaches and leads My bond-servants astray so that they commit <i>acts of immorality</i> and eat things sacrificed to idols.<sup>21</sup> I gave her time to repent, and she does not want to repent of her immorality.<sup>22</sup> Behold, I will throw her on a bed of sickness, and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation, unless they repent of her deeds.</p>	Rev. 3:8 <p>'I know your deeds. Behold, I have put before you an open door which no one can shut, because you have a little power, and have kept My word, and have not denied My name.</p>	Rev. 3:15-16 <p>'I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot; I wish that you were cold or hot.<sup>16</sup> So because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of My mouth.</p>

Rev. 2:24-25 'But I say to you, the rest who are in Thyatira, who do not hold this teaching, who have not known the deep things of Satan, as they call them--I place no other burden on you.'	Rev. 3:2-4 'Wake up, and strengthen the things that remain, which were about to die; for I have not found your deeds completed in the sight of My God.' So remember what you have received and heard; and keep it, and repent.	Rev. 3:9-11 'Behold, I will cause those of the synagogue of Satan, who say that they are Jews and are not, but lie--I will make them come and bow down at your feet, and make them know that I have loved you.'

'Because you have not kept the word of My gold refined by fire so that you may become rich, and white garments so that you may clothe yourself, and that the shame of your nakedness will not be revealed; and eye salve to anoint your eyes so that you may see.'
				'I am coming quickly; hold fast what you have, so that no one will take your crown.'	'Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline; therefore be zealous and repent.'
					'Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and will dine with him, and he with Me.'

Rev. 2:17 'To him who overcomes, to him I will give some of the hidden manna,'	Rev. 2:26-28 'He who overcomes, and he who keeps My deeds until the end, to him I will give authority over the nations.'	Rev. 3:5 'He who overcomes will thus be clothed in white garments; and I will not erase his name from the book of life, and I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels.'	Rev. 3:12 'He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will not go out from it anymore; and I will write on him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God, and My new name.'
